


U.S. Life Expectancy



Productive Aging

A philosophy of aging that views older adults as:

- An opportunity rather than a crisis
- A solution rather than a problem
- An asset rather than a burden
- A resource rather than a drain on resources; and
- A group that can make social, economic, cultural and spiritual contributions rather than simply an expanding portion of the population.





What Does Aging in Community Mean?

- ► The choice to age in community is a call to action, not a preservation of the status quo.
- Considerations for your decision to age in community:
 - Built environment: Is the home accessible? What about public spaces?
 - Social: Do you have connections to keep you from isolation. Who will you turn to when you need help?
 - Health: Do you have access to quality providers? The ability to manage changes in your health status?
 - Mobility: What is the plan if you cannot drive any longer? Do you know the resources?
 - Financial: Do you know how much you will need to accomplish your goals? Do you have enough?

Our lost social infrastructure...

- Most suburban neighborhoods are not built with community life in mind. Cities are no different.
- ► Two-income economy created a vacuum in the neighborhoods who is there to form the network?
- Modern life-style revolved around two hubs: work and nucleus family
- Many retirees feel the double loss of work and kids
- Monetizing mindset fails to recognize the value of the social fabric of communities.
- Lack of conscious investment caused disintegrated communities

We are at a unique point in time:

- Boomer generation entering retirement
- According to AARP study, close to 90% plan to age at their current home
- Many of our communities are not designed for aging in place
- ► Villages tap into people's desire for:
 - autonomy and self determination
 - Community and connectedness



What is a Village?

A local, volunteer-led organization that brings people together and coordinates neighbors helping neighbors support.

Communities design their own village based on their unique make up, interests, and needs.


Some choose a multigenerational model.

Services may include social engagement and a variety of support services.



Villages Services

- Social activities (meeting at local café, featured speakers, walking groups, book clubs)
- Volunteer transportation
- Referrals to services (vetted, member recommended, partner businesses)
- Limited in-home support (meals, laundry, home repairs, pet care and more)
- Computer help
- Friendly calling and visiting
- Much more!




Partnerships

- 6. Technology Companies


